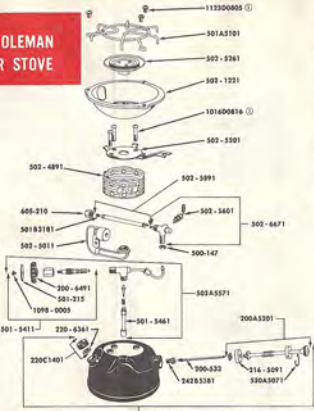

HOW TO USE AND ENJOY YOUR NEW



502-700 SPORTSTER STOVE

ALWAYS USE THE RIGHT KIND OF FUEL

The length of service you get from your stove and generator depends greatly upon the kind of fuel you use. Substances in gasoline that do not vaporize will stop up and shorten the life of your generator.

Use only Coleman Stove and Lantern Fuel or clean "white" gasoline; never use fuel containing lead compounds or lubricating oils. Store your fuel in a clean, closed metal container. (Glass containers are dangerous—may break.) If Coleman Stove and Lantern Fuel or ordinary "white" gasoline is not available at your favorite service station, most oil companies will gladly tell you where to obtain it.



TO PUMP AIR PRESSURE INTO FOUNT

Shut-off valve and filter cap must be closed. Turn pump plunger knob two complete turns to the left. Place thumb over small hole in knob and pump 20 to 25 full strokes. Turn pump plunger knob to the right and tighten firmly with fingers. Air may be added while stove is lighted or in operation without closing shut-off valve.

ALUMINUM CASE for Sportster. Lightweight, corrosion resistant, has detachable handle. Lid is 6" by pan. Bottom—two-quart sauce pan. Buy it from your Coleman dealer!

502-952 HEAT DRUM

HEAT DRUM designed for the Sportster Stove. Perfect for heating duck blinds, fishing cabins, tents, etc. Buy it from your Coleman dealer!

TO FILL FOUNT

Close shut-off valve (1) by turning valve wheel to the right. Unscrew filler cap (2). With stove in level position, fill with clean, fresh fuel. Fount holds approximately one pint. Replace filler cap and tighten firmly with fingers. Never remove filler cap while the stove is lighted or near flame or excessive heat.

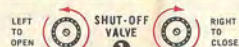


TO LIGHT STOVE

1. Rotate cleaner-regulator lever (3) several times to be sure tip is clean. Leave lever pointing away from stove to avoid flooding while lighting.
2. Light a lighted match above the burner and open shut-off valve (1) 1/4 turn to left.
3. During the lighting process, a small amount of air from the tank is consumed. Maintain strong flame by pumping air into the fount (4) as required. (CAUTION: Hold stove firmly on level surface while pumping.)
4. After stove has been burning 1-2 minutes and the flame is blue, open shut-off valve (1) wide. Flame may be adjusted by turning cleaner-regulator lever (3).

TO TURN STOVE OFF

Turn shut-off valve wheel (1) to the right until closed.



THE HIKERS' FRIEND

Slip a light 30-inch webbing strap (or strong cord) through the three loops provided on the cook kit 501-960. It can be hung securely on the outside of your pack or on your belt, with the stove in it. This gives a neat pack containing stove and utensils.



GENERAL SUGGESTIONS

KEEP BURNER CLEAN. An obstruction such as a burned match head near the burner ports will produce a yellow flame at that point.

THE PUMP PLUNGER not only pumps air into the tank but acts as a wrench to turn the air stem. Turned to the left, it opens the air stem so air may be forced through check valve. Turned to the right, the air stem closes the check valve and provides a positive shutoff. Air pressure may be added while the stove is burning. (2) The leather, occasionally for top efficiency.

KEEP TANK CLEAN by rinsing it occasionally with clean fuel.

BEFORE STORING STOVE, clean the entire stove—burner, tank, case—and it will give you years of dependable service.

THE STOVE GENERATOR changes liquid fuel to a vapor. Eventually it may fill with carbon, so no fuel can be forced through it. Avoid problems by keeping a spare generator No. 502-5881 on hand.

THE GASKET in filter cap may deteriorate with age. It might be well to install a new No. 220-6361 gasket and disc assembly occasionally.

VALVE PACKING NUTS should be checked for tightness each season before being put into service. To be sure that there is no evidence of leaks, and that there is a medium drag on valve stem.

CONTACT YOUR DEALER for service assistance or parts for your stove. (In case The Coleman Co., Inc., is notified that your stove is No. 502-700.)
